BOARD TERMS ARE JANUARY 1 THROUGH DECEMBER 31 OF THE SECOND YEAR. 2021 BOARD MEMBERS BEGIN SERVICE ON JANUARY 1, 2021, AND COMPLETE THEIR TERMS AT 11:59 PM ON DECEMBER 31, 2023. A QUORUM, CONSISTING OF AT LEAST 15% OF THE CLUB MEMBERSHIP, IS REQUIRED TO HOLD AN ELECTION.
