HAM PLATES DISPLAY



A while back, there was an article in the LOG about Amateur Radio call license plates. Getting the inherited trait of never throwing anything away, I kept some of the more recent Ham plates of my dad (Ed Doehling, WØHQE/SK), brother (Larry Doehling, WAØOHM), and myself.

In a stroke of luck, I had a friend who collected license plates for a hobby. Through a few horse trades, he acquired both of the original ham plates from 1952 that Dad had, as he was

licensed in late 1951 or early 1952. The first year that ham plates were produced in Nebraska was 1952, so this was quite a find.

I took the plate that had the most rust on it and had it restored by a friend in the auto body business so it looks as good as new. In 1953, the plates had a metal tab with a number three that bolted over the right side of the plate instead of putting on a new sticker as we do now.

I will have these plates on display at the Central Nebraska Amateur Radio Club's 60th Annual Steak Fry and Hamfest, held at Bader Park, northeast of Grand Island on July 24 and 25.

ARRL TO EXTEND FIELD DAY RULE WAIVERS FROM 2020 ADD CLASS D AND E POWER LIMIT



The COVID-19 pandemic-modified <u>ARRL Field Day</u> rules from 2020 will continue this June with the addition of a power limit imposed on Class D (Home Stations) and Class E (Home Stations-Emergency Power) participants.

The news from the ARRL Board's Programs and Services Committee comes as many clubs and groups are starting preparations for Field Day in earnest. Field Day 2021 will take place June 26–27.

"This early decision should alleviate any hesitancy that radio clubs and individual Field Day participants may have with their planning for the event," said ARRL Contest Program Manager Paul Bourque, N1SFE.

FOR FIELD DAY 2021

- Class D stations may work all other Field Day stations, including other Class D stations, for points. This year, however, Class D and Class E stations will be limited to 150 W PEP output.
- An aggregate club score will be published just as it was done last year. The aggregate score will be a sum of all individual entries that attributed their score to that of a specific club.

ARRL Field Day is one of the biggest events on the Amateur Radio calendar. Last summer, a record 10,213 entries were received.

"With the greater flexibility afforded by the rules waivers, individuals and groups will still be able to participate in Field Day, while still staying within any public health recommendations and/or requirements," Bourque said.

The preferred method of submitting entries after Field Day is via the web applet. The ARRL Field Day rules include instructions on how to submit entries, which must be submitted or postmarked by Tuesday, July 27, 2021.
