Techs: Now is the Time to Upgrade to General

As of July 1, 2023, there is a new question pool for General-class license exams. The new question pool is valid for examinations taken between July 1, 2023 and June 30, 2027.

ARRL has released new versions of its study resources - the 10th edition of The ARRL General Class License Manual, and the 7th edition of ARRL's General Q&A.

ARRL has also updated its free online review and practice resource, ARRL Exam Review for Ham Radio.
