Tuesday 01/06/2026 18:00 to Tuesday 01/13/2026 17:59 CST

The ARRL is holding a year-long contest in honor of America's 250th birthday. Each week several States will be hosts, operators in these States will operate as W1AW/region code, W1AW/0 in our case. Each state gets two weeks during the year to act as hosts. Each week begins at 00:00Z on a Wednesday and goes till the following Tuesday at 23:59Z. Central Standard Time is currently 6 hours behind Zulu time (-6), this means that the contest times go from Tuesday at 18:00 hours to the following Tuesday at 17:59 CST.

YOUR HELP IS NEEDED! The contest starts this week and Nebraska and New York are the first States to host. Translated that means we start hosting at 18:00 Tuesday January 6th! We will be on the air by the time this newsletter arrives in the mail.

Generally all modes and all bands, except 60 meters, including the WARC bands are allowed. Contacts must be peer to peer. See the ARRL for additional information. Below is a partial list of the Dates and States that will be hosts.
